

Detailed information regarding the Internship

- We accept all applications including MD, DO, and International
- Applicants must be able to commit and complete the 9-week internship
- The program has flexible start and end dates between May and September
- Please have the LOR's sent to email carrie.little@Atriumhealth.org
- After application review and screening, some are offered a virtual interview. The selection committee reviews applicants based on objective criteria and fit for the program. Please do not email the program coordinator for more details on the selection process.
- From the 100s of applicants, only 2 are selected for each summer.
- The Ross Summer students can attend the Department of Surgery and Trauma Section conferences/lectures. They can also attend medical student and resident didactic session.
- Clinical research involves Trauma and Trauma Critical Care. Clinical exposure includes Trauma, Critical Care, General and Subspeciality Surgery. There is no Pediatric specific experience.
- All research studies are assigned by the preceptor
- The internship is located on Atrium Health Carolina Medical Center Main Campus

- The internship is paid, and applicants will receive \$18.50/hr up to 40 hours a week. There is no overtime and no holiday pay.
