### Core Rotations Yr 1 (16 weeks)

1. Inpatient Hospital Medicine: Will include management of patients admitted to the general inpatient pediatric team (CHIPS), including inpatient and progressive status patients on the acute care floor. This includes surgical co-management with General Surgery, Orthopedics, Neurosurgery, ENT, etc. Fellows will be responsible for supervising residents and medical students.
2. Newborn Nursery: Will include delivery coverage as well as supervision of residents and medical students. Fellows will spend time at both the high volume nursery at our academic center and at the level II Nursery at a community site where hospitalists cover deliveries.
3. Complex Care: Will include time on inpatient complex care team as well as the option for time in outpatient complex care clinic as part of the Individualized Curriculum.

Research/Scholarly Activity (16 weeks): Will consist of non-continuous protected time. Will include Advocacy curriculum.

Individualized Curriculum/Electives (16 weeks): Suggested electives/individualized rotations include: Child Protection, Palliative Care, Sedation, Pediatric Emergency Medicine, Pediatric Behavioral Health, Pediatric Infectious Disease, Pediatric Pulmonology, Telemedicine via Hospital at Home, Global Health (Certificate), Pediatric Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Pediatric Hematology/Oncology, Pediatric Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation

Vacation: Fellows are granted 4 weeks of PTO/vacation per year which can be taken in 1 week increments.
