CPE INTERN PROGRAMS 2025-2026

All programs of Clinical Pastoral Education at Atrium Health are accredited for Level I and Level II CPE by the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE). CPE programs consist of 400 hours, at least 100 of which are structured group and individual education. Tuition is \$450.

Extended unit classes are scheduled one day per week, with clinical ministry time negotiated according to the need of the healthcare facility and the CPE student. Extended units involve 4-6 hours of class time, plus 8-15 hours of clinical time per week. Extended students meet every other week with a CPE supervisor. Some of the extended units offer the opportunity of using up to 100 hours of current ministry work in a parish or religious setting as part of a student's clinical hours, as approved by the Clinical Educator. Some extended interns also participate in on-call rotations.

Atrium Health Facilities Offering CPE

- ♦ Behavioral Health Davidson is a 66-bed in-patient psychiatric hospital with three adult units. Behavioral Health Charlotte, located in uptown Charlotte, NC is a 66-bed in-patient psychiatric hospital with two adult units and one child/adolescent unit. These centers serve a broad range of people who suffer from chronic mental health disorders or have more acute episodic needs. Education is held in Davidson. Students will provide pastoral care to patients and lead spirituality groups and chapel services.
- ◆ Cabarrus is comprised of an extensive inpatient and outpatient network that services the residents of multiple counties through 457 acute care beds. Approximately 300 physicians are members of the active medical staff. Home to Jeff Gordon Children's Hospital. In addition, Atrium Health Cabarrus has six Centers of Excellence: Levine Cancer Center, Cannon Heart Center, Diagnostics and Imaging Center, Emergency Care Center, Hayes Family Center and Surgery Center.
- ♦ Carolinas Medical Center in Charlotte, NC, is a national leader in specialized care for a broad range of medical conditions. CMC is the <u>largest research hospital</u> in the region and one of five <u>teaching hospitals</u> in North Carolina. With 874 licensed beds, CMC has specialty programs, including neurosciences, orthopedics, rehabilitation, surgery, trauma, and women's services.
- ♦ Cleveland in Shelby is a 241-bed hospital serving greater Cleveland County, NC, and the surrounding region. It was the first Level III trauma center in NC, offering advanced emergency care. AH Cleveland also offers outpatient cancer care through the Levine Cancer Institute Cleveland
- ♦ Mercy was established in 1906 by the Sisters of Mercy as the first Catholic Hospital in North Carolina. CMC-Mercy is licensed for 162 beds. As an adult acute care facility, Atrium Health Mercy provides a full-range of services, from emergency room care to surgery to rehabilitation. We serve as the home to some of the area's most advanced specialty services, such as complex orthopedic surgery, bariatric surgery, The Center for Pelvic Health and Horizons, an 11 bed in-patient detoxification unit.
- ♦ Union is a 175-bed hospital in Monroe, NC, providing comprehensive emergency services and specialty medical care for the past 15-plus years. The campus offers a variety of medical services, including a day surgery center, cancer treatment center, long-term care facility, behavioral health center, specialty care clinics, a community wellness and outreach program, a women and children's center, interventional heart program and physician practices.
- ♦ Roof Above is a comprehensive homeless service provider serving 1,200 people per day through a spectrum of services ranging from street outreach, day services, emergency shelter, and permanent supportive housing. Roof Above's organizational goal is to unite communities to end homelessness, one life at a time.
