Dear Applicant

Enclosed you will find the Delineation of Privileges Form specific to your specialty. This form reflects the minimum qualifications as outlined and approved by the Atrium Health Medical Staff.

- Please thoroughly review and select your desired clinical privileges. Check the box corresponding to the privileges that you are requesting. Applicants should only request those privileges where the criteria has been achieved.
- After you have selected your privileges, sign, date, and submit the **required documentation** for each privilege selected. (i.e. case logs, fellowship director letter, ACLS documentation)
- Where case logs are required, please include 1) Date of procedure, 2) Medical Record Number, 3) Procedure Type and 4) Privilege Number listed on the Delineation of Privileges Form.
- Privileges for which you have not selected or do not meet the minimum criteria cannot be performed.
- If you wish to perform privileges and do not have documentation of the minimum criteria requirements as outlined on the Delineation of Privileges Form, you will need to request permission to proctor through Medical Staff Services.
- Failure to return the Delineation of Privileges Form along with the required documentation will **delay** your start date.

**SUMMARY OF OCCUPATION:**

1. The Advanced Practice Provider is a skilled member of the health care team who is qualified by academic and clinical education and experience to provide patient services as an Advanced Practice Provider under the supervision of a member(s) of the Medical Staff of Atrium Health in accordance with the Bylaws of the Medical Staff.
2. He/she shall assist in the implementation of the health care plan and the management of patients by performing diagnostic and therapeutic tasks as defined and approved by the Board, and authorized under applicable law.
3. For purposes of this form, Advanced Practice Provider shall mean a "Dependent Practitioner" defined as a health care professional other than physicians or dentists, who is approved by the Board, who is licensed or certified by his/her respective licensing or certifying agencies, and who provides service under the supervision of a physician who is currently appointed to the Medical Staff of Atrium Health.

**ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP:**

1. The Advanced Practice Provider shall only exercise those clinical privileges maintained by the supervising physician(s) and approved by the Board. The Advanced Practice Provider may also assist the residents assigned to the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology in performance of their duties and responsibilities as assigned by their supervising physician. The Advanced Practice Provider shall notify the supervising physician of all cases of acute and severe distress, serious nature (life- or limb-threatening), or whenever the patient wishes to see a physician or has unanswered questions.
2. The Advanced Practice Provider shall perform all privileges in accordance with all laws and regulations pertaining to the scope of practice for his or her health profession. The Advanced Practice Provider shall wear a nametag identifying him/herself as an Advanced Practice Provider and introduce him/herself as an Advanced Practice Provider, and shall at no time imply, state, or lead one to believe that he/she is a physician.
3. The Advanced Practice Provider must conduct all duties and responsibilities in accordance with departmental and hospital policies and procedures.
4. A nurse or secretary who receives an order from an Advanced Practice Provider for medication(s), laboratory or radiological studies, and/or treatment is authorized to perform that order as if it were received from a physician.
5. The supervising physician(s) must sign the Delineation of Privileges form of the Advanced Practice Provider, accepting responsibility for appropriate supervision, and shall intervene and directly assume the care of any patient when requested by the patient or the Advanced Practice Provider, required by hospital policies and procedures, or when in the interest of patient care. The supervising physician(s) shall co-sign entries on the medical records of patients seen or treated by the Advanced Practice Provider as required by hospital policies and procedures.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. The Advanced Practice Provider shall maintain qualifications as specified in the POLICY ON CLINICAL PRIVILEGES FOR ADVANCED PRACTICE PROVIDERS. His/her past experience and training shall be commensurate with privileges requested.
2. The scope of duties and responsibilities of the Advanced Practice Provider shall be delineated on an approved Delineation of Privileges form and approved by the Board.

**QUALIFICATION – continued:**

3. The Supervising Physician shall delegate only tasks and procedures to his or her Advanced Practice Provider which are within or contemplated by the clinical privileges granted to the Supervising Physician by the Medical Executive Committee and the Board of Commissioners and which the Advanced Practice Provider has been approved to perform. It is understood that the supervision of an Advanced Practice Provider shall never be transferred to a physician who is not currently a fully appointed member of Atrium Health Medical Staff.
4. If the Medical Staff appointment or Clinical Privileges of the Sponsoring Physician are resigned, revoked or terminated, the Advanced Practice Provider's permission to practice shall automatically terminate and his or her clinical privileges shall be automatically relinquished.

**SUPERVISION:**

Except where the Delineation of Privileges form provides for Personal Supervision or Proximate Supervision, General Supervision (as defined below) will be required for all tasks and procedures performed by the Advanced Practice Provider.

1. "General Supervision" shall mean the procedure is furnished under the supervising physician's overall direction and control, but the physician is not required to be present during the procedure. General Supervision requires the performance of tasks and procedures in a manner that is consistent with state law, the applicable standard of care, Medical Staff Bylaws and hospital policies and procedures, but does not require Personal Supervision or Proximate Supervision, as those terms are defined below.
2. "Proximate Supervision" shall mean the physical presence of a sponsoring/supervising physician in the hospital, in close proximity and immediately available to furnish assistance and direction to the Advanced Practice Provider as needed.
3. "Personal Supervision" shall mean the physical presence of a sponsoring/supervising physician in the room with the Advanced Practice Provider during the performance of a procedure.

To be eligible for **Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM) Core Privileges**, the applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- If the applicant completed their CNM training program in the past two (2) years, the applicant must:
  1. Provide documentation of successful completion of an accredited Nurse Midwifery graduate program where you participated in direct patient care in the hospital setting; **AND**
  2. Verification from the program director that the Applicant successful completed the program. Experience must include evidence of current clinical competence during the past two (2) years. The Applicant has the burden of producing information deemed adequate by the Hospital for a proper evaluation of current competence, and other qualifications and for resolving any doubts; **OR**
  2. If you are unable to provide current clinical competence during the past two (2) years, check the applicable core privilege "Proctoring Requested" box(s) to indicate to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator that you require proctoring. You must provide documentation of proctoring for thirty (30) encounters related to CNM Core Privileges, ten (10) of which must be vaginal deliveries.
- If the applicant completed their CNM training program greater than two (2) years ago, the applicant must:
  1. Demonstrate that he/she has provided inpatient services for at least thirty (30) patients, ten (10) of which must be vaginal deliveries if applying for CAPP-CNM-1 Certified Nurse Midwife Core Privileges, for services directly related to the CNM core privilege requested, during the past two (2) years in an accredited hospital or healthcare facility; **OR**
  1. Check the applicable core privilege "Proctoring Requested" box(s) to indicate to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator that you require proctoring. You must provide documentation of proctoring for thirty (30) encounters related to CNM Core Privileges, ten (10) of which must be vaginal deliveries.

To be eligible for **Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM) Outpatient Only Core Privileges**, the applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- If the applicant completed their CNM training program in the past two (2) years, the applicant must:
  1. Provide documentation of successful completion of an accredited Nurse Midwifery graduate program where you participated in direct patient care; **AND**

2. Verification from the program director that the Applicant successful completed the program. Experience must include evidence of current clinical competence during the past two (2) years. The Applicant has the burden of producing information deemed adequate by the Hospital for a proper evaluation of current competence, and other qualifications and for resolving any doubts; **OR**
2. If you are unable to provide current clinical competence during the past two (2) years, check the applicable core privilege "Proctoring Requested" box(s) to indicate to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator that you require proctoring. You must provide documentation of proctoring for thirty (30) encounters related to CNM Outpatient Only Core Privileges.

If the applicant completed their CNM training program greater than two (2) years ago, the applicant must:

1. Demonstrate that he/she has provided services for at least thirty (30) patient encounters directly related to the CNM Outpatient Only Core Privilege requested, during the past two (2) years in an accredited hospital or healthcare facility; **OR**
1. Check the applicable core privilege "Proctoring Requested" box(s) to indicate to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator that you require proctoring. You must provide documentation of proctoring for thirty (30) encounters related to CNM Outpatient Only Core Privileges.

**NOTE 2: Advanced Practice Providers must apply for "CORE" privileges in order to be eligible for special procedure clinical privileges at any facility within Atrium Health.**

**NOTE 3: Please note that the exercise of certain privileges enumerated herein is necessarily limited by the operational and resource constraints of the facility. All procedures must be performed within a clinical setting with the capabilities and organizational structure required to provide appropriate support.**

**NOTE 4: If you are unable to meet the competency criteria defined by the Medical and Dental Staff for core and/or special privileges, you will need to request permission to proctor by selecting the applicable proctoring box(s) below. Proctoring is required for privileges when an applicant/appointee does not meet the initial eligibility qualifications or reappointment criteria.**

			N/A					N/A		CAPP-CNM-1	Manage and provide care to adolescent and adult females focusing on pregnancy, childbirth, the post-partum period, gynecological needs, and the care of the newborn.  The Advanced Practice Provider may not admit patients to the hospital but may initiate/place orders on behalf of the supervising physician.	

The Advanced Practice Provider may, in consultation with the supervising physician, perform the following duties: initiate/place orders on behalf of the supervising physician after notification of collaborating physician; collect specimens for pathological examination; order diagnostic testing and therapeutic modalities; initiate referral to appropriate physician; make daily rounds on hospitalized patients with or at the direction of the supervising physician; perform field infiltrations of anesthetic solutions; perform history and physical examinations; record progress notes; write discharge summaries.

**Labor and Post-Partum Management:** Management of labor and delivery for patients requesting nurse midwifery care in the course of their pregnancy as requested and allowed by supervising physicians. Perform cervical examinations for assessment of labor progress; fetal monitoring using fetoscope, doptone, internal or external fetal monitor; Intrauterine pressure catheter; Perform amniotomies, conduct fetal surveillance, co-manage with physician selected moderate and high-risk perform induction of labor; initiate amnio-infusion; interpret fetal monitor tracing; includes management of women with a previous Cesarean section with a documented low-transverse uterine scar; administer local or pudendal anesthesia or order epidural anesthesia when indicated. Management of normal spontaneous birth with collaborating physician or designee readily available to respond to any call for assistance: Perform cord blood sampling; explore the uterus and manually remove placenta fragments; perform midline/mediolateral episiotomies and repair; repair of lacerations; third and fourth degree extensions; manage deliveries of singleton, vertex presentations; perform bimanual compression of the uterus for immediate postpartum hemorrhage; Suprapubic pressure, McRoberts maneuver, Wood-Screw maneuver, manual delivery of the posterior arm, and/or fracture of the clavicle for shoulder dystocia; Ultrasound for fetal position or confirmation of IUPD; Consultations with anesthesiologist on call when epidural anesthesia is indicated or requested. Medical management of post-partum hemorrhage following delivery of the placenta; Umbilical cord blood gases may be obtained.

**Care of Emergency Patients:** Provide manual elevation of the presenting part for prolapsed cord; Notify collaborating physician and manage Shoulder Dystocia; Malpresentation other than vertex; Multiple gestation undiagnosed until labor; Postpartum hemorrhage/uterine inversion; and Amniotic fluid embolism.

**Postpartum Management:** Perform hemorrhage stabilization with physician consultation if needed; manage midwifery elements of selected high-risk conditions after consultation with physician; monitor vital signs, lochia, fundus, and bladder functions in the immediate postpartum period; and conduct postpartum rounds and examinations.

2. Demonstrate current competence and evidence of performance within the past two (2) years of at least the “minimum number required” as indicated above; **OR**
2. Check the applicable privilege “Proctoring Requested” box(s) to indicate to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator that you require proctoring. You must provide documentation of proctoring for at least the “minimum number required” as indicated above.

**REAPPOINTMENT CRITERIA FOR CONTINUED PRIVILEGES (CAPP-CNM-1(a) and APP-CNM-1(b)):**

The APP must submit a minimum of two (2) cases, for each privilege held, over the past two (2) years based on acceptable results of ongoing professional practice evaluation and outcomes to reapply for current special privileges. This will be reviewed at the time of reappointment. If you are unable to meet the required case volume, indicate so to your Medical Staff Services Coordinator who can assist you with the permission to proctor process.

**\*First Assist to Surgeon is defined by the Medical and Dental Staff as:**

- Communicating the surgeon’s preferences and specific patient needs to surgical team.
- Positioning the patient to provide the necessary exposure for the procedure, as well as the surgeon preference.
- Providing intraoperative skills such as visualization, trocar insertion, injection of local anesthetics, hemostasis, tissue handling, placement and securing of wound drains, and closure of body planes.
- Proficiency in technical skills required during a surgical procedure, including, but not limited to, clamping, cauterizing, suturing, inserting, injecting, manipulating, retracting, cutting, and ligating tissue as necessary.
- Utilizing appropriate suturing techniques, according to surgeon preference, to close the incision at the end of the procedure.
- Providing postoperative skills in patient care such as applying dressings to surgical wounds, patient transfer and transport, transfer of care, and monitoring for immediate complications.
- Collaborating with others to provide continuity of care.

The Advanced Practice Provider may, in consultation with the supervising physician, perform the following duties: Initiate/place orders on behalf of the supervising physician; assess and record health status of patients through obtaining a complete medical/social history; perform emergent precipitous delivery until Physician arrives; perform a physical examination including rectal and pelvic examinations as indicated based on age and history; write orders for and interpret age-appropriate and condition-specific screening tests, laboratory tests, and diagnostic procedures, pharmacological interventions, and non-pharmacological interventions; consult and collaborate with other health care providers as appropriate and initiate referral to appropriate physician; prescribe/order IV fluids, IV drugs, blood products, X-ray, EKG and electrolytes; review electro physiologic and hemodynamic status; perform incision and drainage of superficial abscesses; perform wound debridement and general care of superficial wounds and minor superficial surgical procedures; provide contraceptive care; administer health and wellness counseling; counsel and instruct patients and significant others as appropriate; perform evaluation and treatment of common vaginal infections; monitor and manage stable acute and chronic illnesses of the population served; removal of tubes and drains; care before, during and after pregnancy; obtain doptones; screen and refer for other health problems including suspected sexual abuse and rape; perform STD screen and follow-up; provide post-hospital instructions to patients related to prescribed care, treatments, activities, exercises, diet, and medications, schedule follow-up appointments and therapies as appropriate, make postpartum rounds at the hospital, write progress notes and discharge summaries, provide appropriate patient education regarding purpose, regimens, side effects, possible interactions of medications and/or treatments, cost, and alternative treatments or procedures; epidermal and dermal suturing.
