

Consider three transportation options:



Complete the <u>Electronic</u> <u>Transfer Request Form</u>



For emergent transfers (e.g., risk for loss of life, loss of limb, code situations {STEMI, Sepsis, Stroke}, call

What IS NOT medically necessary for Ambulance Transports and Transfers?





Below are some potential scenarios where a patient <u>WOULD NOT qualify</u> as medically necessary for an ambulance transport and transfer

A stable pediatric patient transferring for an appendectomy or orthopedic consultation with a legal guardian who can drive them.



A stable patient
with an
extremity
fracture who has
a safe ride
to the facility.



Patient is requesting an ambulance ride but does not meet any medical necessity criterion.
