AF Referral Made Easy

WHY?

 Patients with Atrial Fibrillation (AF) have a 2 times greater risk of death than do those without this disease

WHEN?

- 1. AF diagnosed in the first year
- 2. First AF or Paroxysmal AF (AF that spontaneously converts in <1 week)

WHO?

- Patients with ADVERSE EFFECTS from AF (i.e., repeat cardioversion, hospitalization, exercise intolerance, CHF and Cardiomyopathy)
- 2. Patients already on ANTIARRHYTHMIC MEDICATIONS with recurrent AF
- 3. Patients with SIDE EFFECTS from rate control and antiarrhythmic medications
- 4. Patients who have LIMITATIONS for medical or antiarrhythmic therapy
