

## **Weight Loss Medication Guidelines**

For patients taking medications for weight loss, you will be required to skip a dose prior to your procedure. Please note, these medications are also used for diabetes management. Please refer to the list of medications and instructions below.

## Your medication dosing regimen may be different than what is listed below. In general:

- If you take your medication WEEKLY, do not take the medication for one week prior to your scheduled procedure.
- If you take your medication DAILY, do not take the medication the day prior to your scheduled procedure.

| Medication              | Frequency | When to Stop Medication |
|-------------------------|-----------|-------------------------|
| Semaglutide (Rybelsus)  | Daily     | 1 day prior             |
| Liraglutide (Saxenda)   | Daily     | 1 day prior             |
| Liraglutide (Victoza)   | Daily     | 1 day prior             |
| Lixisenatide (Adlyxin)  | Daily     | 1 day prior             |
| Exenatide ER (Bydureon) | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Dulaglutide (Trulicity) | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Exenatide ER (Bydureon) | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Semaglutide (Ozempic)   | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Semaglutide (Wegovy)    | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Tirzepatide (Mounjaro)  | Weekly    | 1 week prior            |
| Phentermine (Adipex-P)  | Daily     | 2 weeks prior           |
| Phentermine (Lomaira)   | Daily     | 2 weeks prior           |

## Important to remember:

- If you are having an **EGD** you may only have <u>CLEAR LIQUIDS</u> the day prior to your procedure and NOTHING by mouth after 11 p.m.
- If you are having a colonoscopy, you may have clear liquids up until 3 hours prior to your procedure.
- NO SOLID FOOD THE ENTIRE DAY PRIOR TO PROCEDURE
