

CHASSIS 2026 SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Internship Program Objective: To foster professional research skills and inspire students to become tomorrow's leaders in health care innovation.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The LHS Internship Program seeks students interested in careers in the field of health outcomes research to work at the Center for Health System Sciences (CHASSIS) at Atrium Health. Interns will collaborate with their assigned mentor on ongoing research studies with impact on patient care. Interns are expected to be independent, highly motivated and able to work collaboratively.

Interns will have the opportunity to gain experience in applied research and analytics, research communication, interdisciplinary collaboration and professional development in a health system setting. A final presentation will complete the internship.

STUDENT SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

Candidates pursuing a medical degree or Masters or Doctorate in public health, health services research, health informatics, or related field at an accredited program are preferred. Candidates must be eligible to work in the US.

Acceptance into the program is contingent upon academic excellence and preference is given to those with prior experience and/or training in research. The Selection Committee will review applications and match top students with a mentor. Students must complete an interview prior to a formal offer.

INTERN APPLICATION AND PROGRAM DETAILS

Applications for the Summer 2025 program will be accepted from February 9, 2026, through March 23, 2026. Complete applications will include a **cover letter** describing research interests and experiences, an **updated CV**, and **transcript**. Interested candidates should click on the link below to apply. This **10-week paid internship program** begins late May through early August and will involve **20 hours of effort per week** in a hybrid work environment.
