MEDICAL LICENSE REQUIREMENT POLICY**

1. All House Staff will be required to have an active Resident Training License (RTL) or a Full, Unrestricted Medical License issued by the North Carolina Medical Board prior to training at Carolinas Medical Center.
2. North Carolina law requires licensed physicians to renew with the Board within 30 days of their birth date, every year, regardless when the license was issued.
3. The Graduate Medical Education Office at Carolinas Medical Center will notify the Resident or Fellow via email with instructions to renew their RTL prior to the expiration date of license.
4. Residents with a Full, Unrestricted Medical License will be notified by the North Carolina Medical Board prior to the expiration date of license.
5. A Full, Unrestricted North Carolina Medical License will be required for external moonlighting.
6. It is the responsibility of the Resident doing an out-of-state rotation to confirm whether a license is required and to obtain a license in the state before the start of that rotation.
