OUR GOAL: Creating entry paths to health care careers through education and employment opportunities

Rise to Success is a sponsorship program that enables high school graduates to earn an associate's degree or a certification in a health care related discipline from a local community college. Tuition, textbooks, activity fees and scrubs are paid by Atrium Health. While participants are in college, they are hired into an entry-level position.

Participants are expected to work for Atrium Health for the duration of their community college career and an additional year after completion of their associate's degree; participants are also encouraged to earn their bachelor's degree upon program completion.

CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must meet these minimum requirements to be considered for the Rise to Success program.

- · Graduated with a high school diploma (*18 years of age by June 15)
- Minimum 3.00 GPA
- Must complete and submit all required application materials

Participants are expected to obtain an associate's dearee or certification in a health care related field.
