

OUR FOCUS: Educating, Hiring and Training the Next Generation of Health care Professionals

Rise to Success is a sponsorship program that enables high school graduates to earn an associate degree or a certification in a health care related discipline from a local community college. Tuition, textbooks, activity fees and scrubs are paid by Atrium Health. While participants are in college, they are hired into an entry-level part-time position.

Participants are expected to work for Atrium Health for the duration of their college career and an additional year after completion of their associate degree; participants are also encouraged to earn their bachelor's degree upon program completion. Participating individuals will have access to a Career Coach who will support their academic and work success throughout the program.

Candidates should have plans to obtain an associate degree or certification in a health care related field* leading to an associate degree. Examples include:

- Have a minimum 3.00 GPA
