

## OUR FOCUS: Educating, Hiring and Training the Next Generation of Health Care Professionals

Rise to Success is a sponsorship program that enables high school graduates to earn an associate's degree or a certification in a health care related discipline from a local community college. Tuition, textbooks, activity fees and scrubs are paid by Atrium Health. While participants are in college, they are hired into an entry-level part-time position.

Participants are expected to work for Atrium Health for the duration of their community college career and an additional year after completion of their associate's degree; participants are also encouraged to earn their bachelor's degree upon program completion. Participating individuals will have access to a career coach who will support their academic and work success throughout the program.

### CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must meet these minimum requirements in order to be considered for the Rise to Success program.

- Graduated with a high school diploma (\*18 years of age by June 1)
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must complete and submit all required application materials

**Participants are expected to obtain an associate's degree or certification in a health care related field.**
