Advocate Health Has Talent FAQ's

Q: Why are Local Talent Shows being held?

A: It is important that all teammates feel connected, engaged and to display a sense of ownership for all Advocate Health Reward and Recognition programs. Local Talent Shows (Auditions) encourage greater participation and a sense of pride among teammates - allowing them to perform and audition close to where they work.

Q: Who is eligible to enter Advocate Health Has Talent!?

A: Entrants must be employed by Advocate Health. Talent Champions, committee members and any previous Advocate Health Has Talent! Grand Finale winners are <u>not</u> eligible. Also, Entrants may <u>not</u> use the same act as they did in previous years.

Q: When are the Local Talent Shows (Auditions)?

A: Local shows will be held Tuesday, May 30 through Friday, June 9 at various locations across the Enterprise.

Q: Are there certain dates that the Grand Finale Finalist will be videotaped in Charlotte?

A: Should you win and advance to the Grand Finale; taping will be on a designated date of June 12 through June 16.

Q: Will travel be provided should I win and advance to the Grand Finale in Charlotte, NC?

A: Yes, travel will be provided. Please discuss with your Talent Champion.

Q: Will I have a chance to rehearse before the local audition show?

A: Since each show is coordinated by a different Talent Champion, some elect for a rehearsal in advance, while others opt to come in early day of the show and give you time to rehearse then. Please ask your designated Talent Champion for help.

Q: When is the Grand Finale and who will be invited to participate?

A: The virtual Finale will be held Friday, August 25 on YouTube. The 1st and/or 2nd Audition place winners - depending on how many you have representing from your audition - will be invited to compete for 1st, 2nd and 3rd, People's Choice and Executive Choice overall titles.

Q: Are teammates paid for participating in the show if audition is during working hours?

A: Please consult your manager first to get approval, but yes, teammates should get compensated if event is during shift hours. It has been a practice to pay non-exempt teammates for their time as part of participation in a company event if it is during normal work hours. This guidance, however, is not addressed in policy but considered a best practice.

Q: Should I win at the local audition; do I have to perform the same act at the Grand Finale?

A: Yes, same act is required at both the local audition show and the Grand Finale.
