Board-certified toxicologists are also on hand to assist the staff when needed. We want North Carolinians to know that by contacting NC Poison Control first, they can often save an Emergency Department visit. NC Poison Control also assists other healthcare providers when help is needed managing poisoned patients.

Close to 30% of calls or chats came from another healthcare provider.




Almost 70% of cases were managed at home (or site of original contact).






