Scotland Health Care System 2021 Community Health Needs Assessment Update

Based on the findings of the 2019 Community Health Needs Assessment the SHCS Board of Trustees approved the Community Health Improvement Plan to address the primary health concerns that were identified. At that time, the major health issues impacting our community were obesity-related diseases, mental health, and a lack of positive youth engagement with respect to health behaviors. Thus, several initiatives were enhanced or initiated to address these needs.

Unfortunately, within the past year and a half the primary health needs of our community have changed dramatically due to the COVID pandemic. Additionally, opportunities to attend or sponsor non-COVID related community health events were severely limited due to health and safety measures that were implemented in our community and throughout the country. As a result, we adjusted our community health emphasis to address the pressing issues of testing and vaccinating our community.

This document provides a brief overview of the programs and opportunities that have taken place throughout FY 2021 to date.
