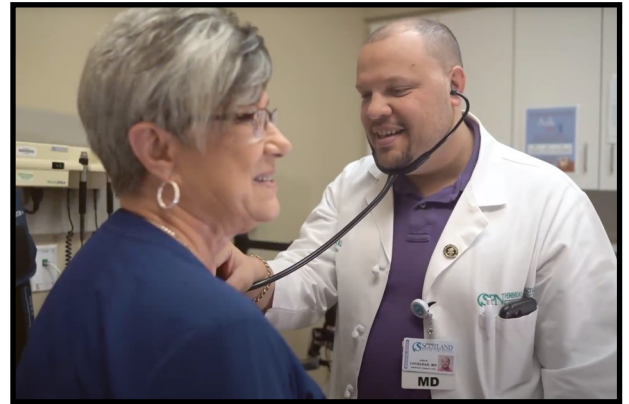

Primary and Urgent Care

Based on your feedback, new services will also include walk-in, same day access for patients at Pembroke Family Practice and Urgent Care. Same-day access and on-site urgent care will provide added convenience to current patients as well as provide improved access for new patients throughout our community. To meet the needs of our community, offering convenient care is a cornerstone of this project.

Housing an on-site pharmacy provides you with quick, easy access to prescribed medications necessary to manage your health issues. This means YOU can have your prescription filled before you step out of the office. We anticipate this will ensure patients have access to needed medications as quickly as possible. The onsite pharmacy improves communication between the physician, pharmacist, and the patient. Getting the right medication to the patient before discharge leads to a decrease in hospitalizations and readmissions, all providing better care for you and your family.

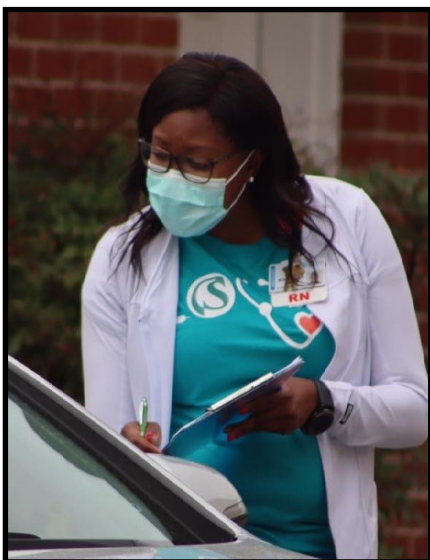
Mental Health Services

This project readily provides for future growth opportunities including mobile mammography, anticipated as early as the summer of 2021. Over the next 5 years, plans for expanded services at the new complex include the addition of nephrology, vascular surgery, and cardiology care through satellite clinics, which will be housed in the specialty services facility in the new complex.
