Cabarrus College clinical programs embrace best practices in healthcare education and prepare students for professional licensure, certification, and practice. Educational requirements to sit for credentialing examinations and to practice vary from one state to the next.

Cabarrus College's Medical Assistant program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Programs (CAAHEP) through recommendation of the Medical Assistant Education Review Board (MAERB). It is designed to prepare students to sit for the national Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) exam administered by the American Association of Medical Assistants. Cabarrus College researched educational requirements for the following states and territories, and per federal requirements, has determined whether or not its program curricula meet educational requirements for licensure/certification. In some instances, the College was unable to make a determination at this time. Please note that each state may have differing scope of practice laws for medical assistants.
