1) P. 149 - Course description updated to: This course is designed as a practicum that provides the student with the opportunity to apply first level management/leadership skills in the clinical or imaging educational setting. The student will analyze the duties of a leadership position under direction of a preceptor. A project will be completed by the student focusing on managerial tasks in the healthcare or imaging educational setting. Included in this course is a service-learning experience focusing on diversity. At the completion of this course the student will; identify common leadership styles, demonstrate managerial skills through completion of projects, and recognize the duties necessary for a leader in the imaging educational or healthcare setting. Prerequisite: HSL300. Credit: 3 Hours. (9 hours clinical). As needed.
