## **GASOLINE SAFETY**

## Two Simple Rules Regarding Gasoline

- 1. Gasoline has only <u>ONE</u> function: TO FUEL AN ENGINE. Never use gasoline as a cleaning fluid or solvent.
- 2. Gasoline should never be used or stored indoors or close to sources of heat or flame.

## ONE GALLON OF GAS = 20 STICKS OF DYNAMITE!

## **GASOLINE SAFETY**

- \*\*Never use gasoline around a flame source, such as burning leaves or brush
- \*Only use gasoline outdoors
- \*Never use gasoline to start charcoal grills
- Fill gas powered equipment when engines are cool
- \*Never carry gasoline in trunk of a car
- \*Never siphon gasoline by mouth
- \*If spilled on clothing, remove and leave outdoors several days to ventilate
- #If gasoline is swallowed, do not induce vomiting
