

# GASOLINE SAFETY

## Two Simple Rules Regarding Gasoline

1. Gasoline has only ONE function: TO FUEL AN ENGINE. Never use gasoline as a cleaning fluid or solvent.
2. Gasoline should never be used or stored indoors or close to sources of heat or flame.

**ONE GALLON OF GAS =20 STICKS OF DYNAMITE!**

## GASOLINE SAFETY

- ✿ Never use gasoline around a flame source, such as burning leaves or brush
- ✿ Only use gasoline outdoors
- ✿ Never use gasoline to start charcoal grills
- ✿ Fill gas powered equipment when engines are cool
- ✿ Never carry gasoline in trunk of a car
- ✿ Never siphon gasoline by mouth
- ✿ If spilled on clothing, remove and leave outdoors several days to ventilate
- ✿ If gasoline is swallowed, do not induce vomiting
