<p>BALANCE</p>  <p>Sudden loss of balance or coordination</p>	<p>EYES</p>  <p>Sudden trouble seeing out of one or both eyes</p>	<p>FACE</p>  <p>Sudden drooping on one side of the face</p>	<p>ARM</p>  <p>Sudden weakness in one arm or leg</p>	<p>SPEECH</p>  <p>Sudden trouble with speech or understanding</p>	<p>TIME</p>  <p>Time to call 911</p>
