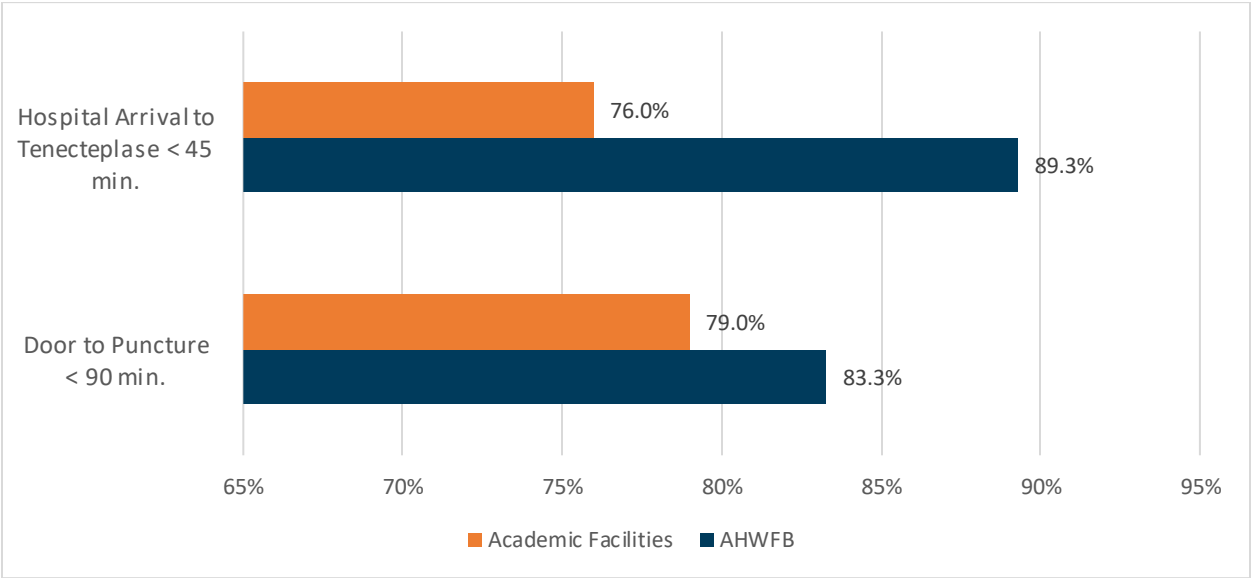

Carotid Procedures at AHWFBMC (FY 25)

For all carotid procedures, there were no procedure-related deaths. Among asymptomatic patients, there were no procedure-related strokes.
