What is CIMT Screening?

CIMT (Carotid Intima-Media Thickness) risk assessment screening is a safe, non-invasive ultrasound test to identify people who are at high risk of heart attack and stroke.

CIMT is just one aspect of cardiovascular risk. There are many other factors that may also contribute to cardiovascular risk.

The goal of CIMT Screening

The goal of CIMT Screening is to detect early atherosclerosis (hardening of the arteries) that leads to heart attack and stroke because of the following facts:

- Heart attack is the number one killer of men and women in the United States. Stroke is number five.
- Heart attack and stroke may be prevented when atherosclerosis is treated in the early stage.

Take Action. Be Proactive with your Health.

Who benefits from having a CIMT Screening?

You can benefit from the screening if you are 40 to 70 years old, do not know if you have vascular or heart disease, and have any of the following risk factors:

- High blood pressure
- Lipid disorders
- Diabetes
- Overweight or obese
- Smoker or a history of smoking
- First degree relative with premature cardiovascular disease (men<55, women<65)

Advantages of CIMT Screening

- · Very early detection
- Non-invasive
- No needles
- No discomfort
- No exposure to radiation
- No injection of contrast agents
- · No risk for allergic reaction

Cost for CIMT Screening

- FREE TO EMPLOYEES AND FAMILY MEMBERS OF WFHS OR NCBH ENROLLED IN MEDCOST HEALTH PLAN WHO MEET THE RISK CRITERIA. MedCost Insurance will be filed for 100% coverage.
- \$275 to those whose insurance does not pay for the screening.

How is CIMT Screening done?

Allow 45 minutes for your visit; it takes about 30 minutes to complete the scan. As you lie on your back, a small amount of gel is applied to the neck and an ultrasound probe is lightly placed on each side of your neck to evaluate the right and left arteries.

How are CIMT Screening results reported?

If you are referred by a healthcare provider, the report is sent to your provider within two weeks and your provider may contact you about the results.

If you are NOT referred by a healthcare provider, a letter outlining your results is sent to you within two weeks.

ECG leads will be attached to your chest for the examination, so consider appropriate clothing such as a shirt with buttons in the front. Examination gowns are available if needed.

- Arrive at **Piedmont Plaza II**, on the


