- Data accessible via the PCORnet
 distributed network draw from millions
 of electronic health records (EHRs) with
 growing links to patient-reported and
 health plan data to create a powerful,
 standard data set that facilitates large scale, multi-site research.
- A COVID-19-specific Common Data Model (CDM) will allow researchers to use information gathered from patients across PCORnet's vast network to better define and understand who is getting infected with SARS-CoV-2 and how the virus affects them.
