About the Robert A. Winn Excellence in Clinical Trials: CAREER DEVELOPMENT AWARD (WINN CDA)



Program Goal

This two-year program supports the career development of early-stage investigator physicians who are committed to transforming and expanding access to the clinical research landscape. They will become community-oriented clinical trialists, who will drive improved health outcomes through their research and mentoring.

Apply by May 12, 2025

Eligibility

- Must have a demonstrated commitment to improving patient participation in clinical trials
- Must be a US Citizen, Lawful Permanent Resident, or hold a H-1B or O-1 Visa
- Must hold the degree of MD, MD/PhD, DO, or DO/PhD
- Must focus on one of the following clinical research areas: cancer, cardiovascular diseases or immunologic disorders
- Must be an early-stage investigator (ESI), as defined by the National Institutes of Health

Program Components

- **Community-Oriented Clinical Trialist (COCT) Training**
 - Winn-AACR Design & Implementation of Clinical Trials Workshop
 - Nov. 17-21, held in Albuquerque, NM
 - 2-year COCT curriculum
 - Scholars forum
 - Annual convenings
 - Capstone project
 - Individual professional development plan
- **Mentorship:** In addition to mentoring from established principal investigators and program mentors, scholars are also expected to:
 - Serve as a mentor to a Winn CIPP student
 - Serve as a peer mentor to future Winn CDA cohorts
