Capri G. Foy, Ph.D., M.S. is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Social Sciences and Health Policy, and an Affiliate Faculty member of the Maya Angelou Center for Health Equity. She is also Co-Director of the Clinical and Population Translational Sciences (CPTS) Master's Degree Program. Dr. Foy's research interests include studying the effect of physical activity upon health-related quality of life and physical function among older adults. She is also interested in designing and examining the effect of theory-based, translatable cognitive-behavioral interventions upon long-term adherence to physical activity among older adults. Another emerging research focus entails examining the role of behavioral risk factors upon chronic disease outcomes using an epidemiological perspective.
