## III. DEFINITIONS/ABBREVIATIONS

*Advanced Placement:* A waiver of required coursework included in the DMSc curriculum for applicants to the program, and/or a waiver of required coursework included in the DMSc curriculum for currently enrolled students in the program which results in the student advancing in the curriculum without completing required curriculum components at the sponsoring institution.

## IV. POLICY

- A. The DMSc Program does not grant advanced placement outside of the School of Medicine or Wake Forest University Graduate School of Arts and Sciences – Biomedical Sciences programs.
