A summer experience for teens interested in a healthcare career

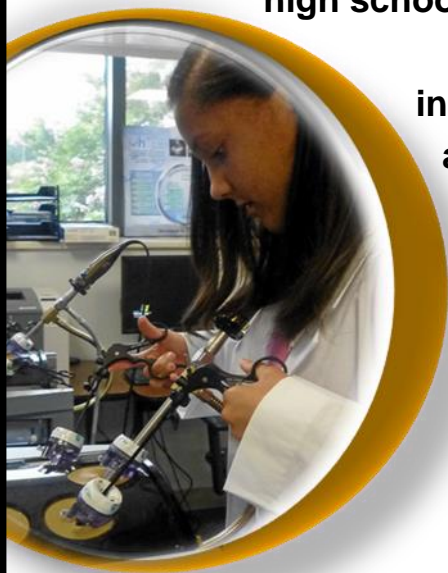


June 22 – 26, 2020

The Health Care Explorers Program is a collaborative initiative with the School of Medicine's Office of Student Inclusion & Diversity and the Winston Lake YMCA. This program annually enrolls 15 to 20 rising 9th & 10th grade underrepresented minorities and disadvantaged high school students to participate in a week-long health careers program that explores a variety of health careers and includes tours of local colleges and universities, as well as an introduction to case-centered learning activities.

This experience culminates in a presentation of research on a chosen career in the healthcare field.
