Wake Forest University School of Medicine is proud to offer scholarship opportunities to help support students who may have special circumstances that would traditionally limit participation in away rotations. These programs provide financial support as part of our focus on creating an educational environment that embodies diversity and inclusion.

OVERVIEW

This program is designed to promote diversity in the residency programs at Wake Forest University School of Medicine and annually offers scholarship assistance to visiting fourth-year medical students.



REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be fourth year, U.S. medical school students in good standing at a medical school accredited by the LCME (Liaison Committee for Medical Education) or the Education Department of the American Osteopathic Association.



FINICIAL ASSISTANCE

Accepted students will receive a stipend to assist with housing and travel expenses.



APPLICATION

Interested students must submit through the AAMC Visiting Student Application Service (VSAS) in addition to the scholarship application. Applicants will only be reviewed after the applicant has been accepted for a visiting clerkship.



ELIGIBILITY

Applicants who are underrepresented in medicine, economically disadvantaged, or first generation are encouraged to apply.
