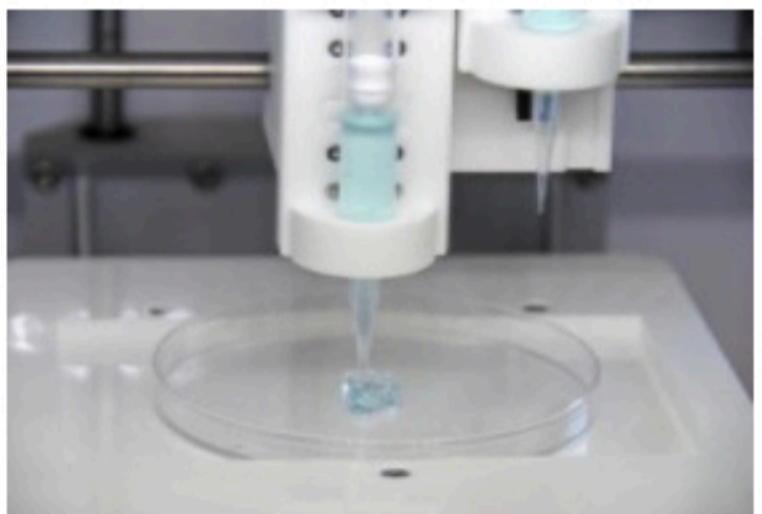
Welcome to our e-newsletter!

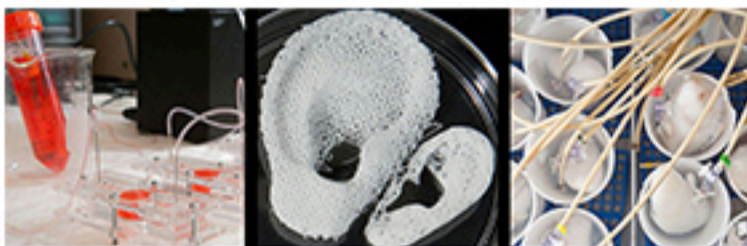
