STUDENT ENROLLMENT

During all of 2023, **574 distinct students** enrolled at Carolinas College of Health Sciences in credit programs. **For the 2023 fall term, 398 students were enrolled in credit programs.**

During 2023, **568** individuals applied for admission to the college with **49.5% being accepted**. Of those accepted, **173 students**, approximately 62% of those accepted, enrolled.

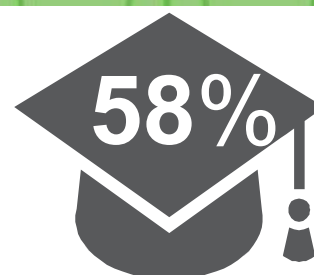

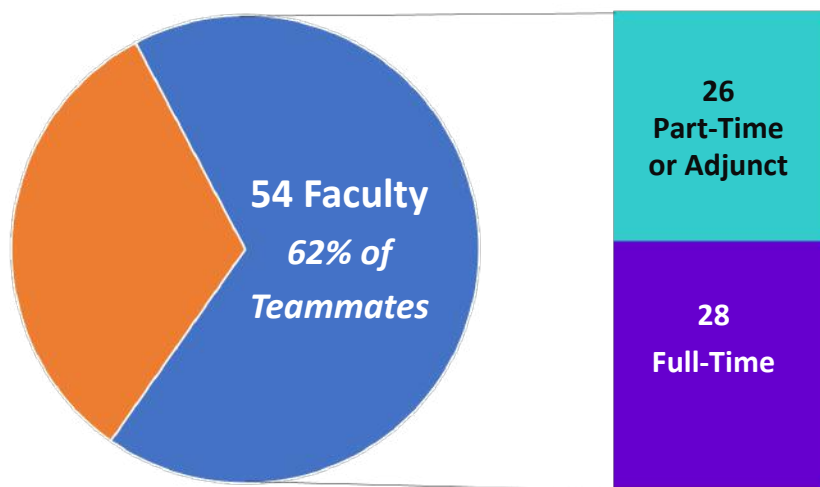
