FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

In accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, as amended, students may review their academic records and prevent disclosure of certain information. The record may be released to a third party only with the written consent of the student or parent of a dependent student, as defined by the Internal Revenue Service, or in certain situation allowed by federal law including public safety concerns, court subpoenas, regulatory, accreditation or federal agency requests, legitimate educational interests or other exceptions. For the purpose of student records, the term "student" includes all matriculating individuals *Directory information:*

Directory information including name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, date of birth, photograph, dates of attendance, degrees, honors and awards received, and participation in college activities may be disclosed without the consent of the student. Students may request nondisclosure of directory information by completing a form available from the registrar. Requests for nondisclosure are valid for one year. *Compliance:*

Students who believe their rights to privacy, as protected by FERPA, have been violated, should notify the dean of student affairs and enrollment management. Students have the right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education Family Policy Compliance Office.
