

**RN-BSN Program
Master Curriculum

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program is a completion program building from the foundation of a prelicensure nursing program curriculum. Designed for the working registered nurse, students can be part-time or full-time. Coursework completed within the pre-licensure program and at other institutions may be eligible for transfer credit.
