

Professional Licensing and Certification Disclosure Nursing

Carolinas College clinical programs embrace best practices in healthcare education and prepare students for professional licensure, certification, and practice. Educational requirements to sit for credentialing examinations and to practice vary from one state to the next.

Carolinas College researched educational requirements for the following states and territories, and per federal requirements, has determined whether or not its program curricula meet educational requirements for licensure/certification. In some instances, the College was unable to make a determination at this time although graduates can sit for NC licensure and practice in these states by virtue of a Compact State License. Please note that each state likely has additional requirements for becoming licensed or certified.
