POLICY

High school seniors who meet prescribed requirements may enroll in general studies courses or in a non-credit program while dually enrolled in high school.

PROCEDURE

- A. High school seniors who meet the following criteria will be granted a waiver of high school graduation as an admission criterion for enrollment in general studies courses or active status in a non-credit program:
 - 1. A rising senior or senior in high school.
 - 2. A 2.5 or better cumulative high school GPA.
 - 3. Written support from a high school guidance counselor or principal.
 - 4. Dually enrolled students must earn a grade of "C" or better in each class to take additional class(es).
 - 5. Must meet minimum age requirements for clinical access.

EARLY COLLEGE (Additional Criteria)

- 1. Students must be accepted into Hawthorne Academy of Health Sciences.
- 2. Must complete Minor Consent, Model, and FERPA forms.
- 3. A 2.5 or better cumulative high school GPA.
- 4. Dually enrolled students must earn a grade of "C" or better in each class to earn the associate degree
- 5. Students earning a "D" in a course may earn high school credit; however, they will need to repeat the course to obtain college credit.
- 6. Must meet minimum age requirements for clinical access.

All other course prerequisites and admission policies/procedures apply.

The Dual Enrollment policy and procedure will be reviewed bi-annually.
