POLICY

Carolinas College of Health Sciences makes available for qualified students both federal and non-federal student aid including Federal grants and loans, work-study, scholarships, and state grants and loans. Additionally, institutional aid is available to qualified students in the form of the Atrium Health Educational Forgiveness Loan and tuition discounting.

The philosophy of student aid is to provide access and choice to students who, without such assistance, would not be able to attend the college. A Financial Aid Policy and Procedures Manual is maintained in the financial aid office and is available for all students to access.

The college is committed to helping students access external sources of aid, as needed.

The dean of student affairs and enrollment management, or designee, will annually audit randomly selected financial aid loan documentation to ensure compliance with department of education and college policies.

The college administers financial aid without regard to race, color, age, religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, veteran status, disability, genetic information, or any other basis prohibited by law.
