POLICY

Peer-Virtual tutoring is offered free of charge as a learning resource for students experiencing academic difficulty through a virtual platform. Tutorial services are provided as a supplement to regular class work and are not a substitute for attendance. Peer tutoring is not formally supported by the college at this time and students are encouraged to reach out to their instructors who are the content experts for additional assistance with content. Students are also encouraged to reach out to the student success coordinator(s) for assistance with study skills and strategies.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Students can sign into our learning management system and select the tutoring link within the Student Success Center course or reach out to our student success coordinator(s) for assistance with how to find and access our current tutoring platform.**
- 2. Student then can sign up or join a tutoring session on the platform on as needed basis.**

The Tutoring Policy will be reviewed bi-annually.
