POLICY

Virtual tutoring is offered free of charge as a learning resource for students experiencing academic difficulty through a virtual platform. Tutorial services are provided as a supplement to regular class work and are not a substitute for attendance. Students are also encouraged to reach out to the student success coordinator(s) for assistance with study skills and strategies.

PROCEDURE

1. Students can sign into our learning management system (Canvas) and select the tutoring link from the course navigation menu within any of their Canvas courses.
2. Students then can sign up or join a tutoring session on the platform on an as needed basis.

The Tutoring Policy will be reviewed bi-annually.
