SUBJECT: SECURITY MEASURES

POLICY

The College will maintain general security measures to ensure the protection of students, teammates, visitors, equipment, and facilities.

PROCEDURE

- A. The Campus Security Authorities (CSA) are defined as the college Security Officer, the Atrium Health Public Safety department, the Chair of the college Safety Committee and the Dean of Student Affairs and Enrollment Management. The CSAs have full authority for the safety and security of the campus. The Atrium Health Public Safety department maintains a working relationship with the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department for ongoing safety and security needs.
- B. All teammates and students must wear the Atrium Health issued identification badge with picture visible and above the waist. Any teammate missing a badge must check in at the entrance and can be assigned a temporary badge from the College Security Officer. Any student missing a badge must check in at the entrance and then go to the Enrollment Suite to arrange a replacement.
- C. Atrium Health Public Safety will provide protective escort services when requested by students, visitors, teammates, and others visiting the college.
- D. Direct telephone communication (Hot Line) to the Atrium Health Security Command Center is 704-355-3333.
- E. Package searches shall be made at any time to deter theft and prevent introduction of unauthorized items into the college. Package searches are at the discretion of Atrium Health Public Safety and/or college administration.
- F. Teammates, students, and visitors can access the college through the main entrance Monday-Friday, 7:30am to 4:30pm. All other entrances remain locked and are accessible via badge. Teammates and students have 24-hour access to the building.
- G. Walkways, parking lots, entrances, and exits shall be provided with appropriate lighting.
- H. The college's security officer provides surveillance (walking rounds) throughout the college and campus grounds during regular business hours with video surveillance 24 hours.
- I. The Security Measures policy and procedure will be reviewed biennially.
